DETAILS

- Please bring your own materials.
- As people walk around to look at the ofrendas & tapetes, we encourage groups to have a few representatives there to explain their work!
- Groups will need to remove their ofrendas and/or tapetes the same day (4:00-5:00pm).
- Youth under 18 who are not accompanied by a parent/guardian must fill out an activity release for minors.
- Ofrendas and tapetes will be judged using the following criteria:
 - Necessary elements are included! Please see guidelines document for details!
 - Creativity
 - Overall appearance
 - Originality
- Individuals interested in the catrín/catrina competition should bring appropriate clothes. People will be here to help paint faces. Competitions for children 0-12 and individuals 12+ years old.
